A REMINDER OF WHAT TODAY WAS ALL ABOUT

It was all about creating a Community Plan for Highams Park!

The objectives of the Launch Event were to:

1. Raise awareness that people who live and work in the area have the opportunity to set up a Community Plan ("the Highams Park Plan").
2. Obtain support from the people for creating the Highams Park Plan.
3. Persuade people to volunteer to help create the Highams Park Plan.
4. Define the borders of Highams Park.

Why have a Community Plan?

Highams Park is a loosely defined area that straddles the wards of Highams Park & Hale End, Hatch Lane, Larkwood and Chapel End and, because of this, no one is responsible for Highams Park as an area. As a consequence, the approach to development in Highams Park has been haphazard and the area has lacked co-ordinated investment in its infrastructure. Creation of the Highams Park Plan will document people's vision of Highams Park and provide the direction to help this vision become our future.

We need to be ready for the next challenges/opportunities that face Highams Park, such as further development around the Tesco site, the handover to TFL of the Chingford Line train service and the dam reinforcement and conservation works at Highams Park Lake.

We think this is an exciting opportunity for the people in the Highams Park area (residents, schools, businesses, shops, etc) to work together to create a better future for Highams Park and to give the people in the area a voice that can be heard!

What happens next?

In January 2014 we will call the volunteers together for a meeting and establish a Steering Group to create the Plan.
